### Energetic

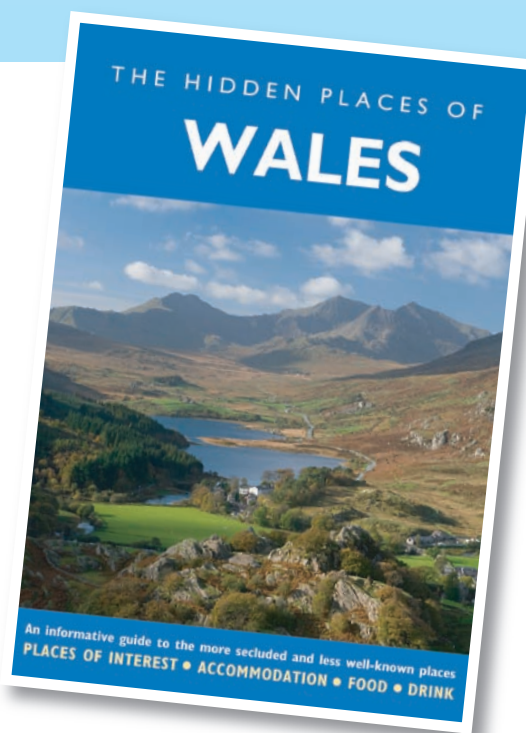

On a bright sunny day why not pack a flask or picnic and head off to **Mwnt** (p136), part of the **Ceredigion Heritage Coast**, this beautiful beach is a perfect sand cove. Steeped in wildlife, it's a great place to spot seals and bottle-nosed, common and Risso dolphins playing among the waves.
